WASHINGTON Sept. 24 - The federal board of vocational education has announced its approval of the plans for vocational education of a number of states for the fiscal year 1919 and has made allotments including Georgia, \$60,948.84.

Kentucky, \$51,701.16, Mississippi, \$42,555.97, North Carolina, \$61,191.24, and Texas, \$91,861.83. Matched by state funds, the amount in each instance is doubled and represents the state expenditure for vocational education.
