VENEREAL DISEASE CONTROL IN PHILADELPHIA H. G. FRETZ, M. D., Ass't Disposition, Bureau of Health

Venereal Diseases were made legally reportable in Philadelphia dating from January 1, 1918. Confidential reporting by serial number in private, and by name in institutional cases was adopted. Official reporting outfits containing case report card, forms regulating a change in physicians, form used in notifying the health authorities when an infectious patient refuses or neglects treatment or otherwise constitutes a public health menace, and a booklet of advice and information on venereal diseases for the patient, were prepared for distribution among physicians. Provisions for the control of the refractory, negligent or indigent infectious patient include the quarantining of the premises or compulsory removal of the patient to a hospital or other institution for isolation and treatment. Cases reported to the Health Department as suspicious of having a communicable venereal disease are required to submit to a medical examination when
