GRADUATE NURSES MEET

Scale of Fees Adopted by the Local Association

The Graduate Nurses Association resumed its regular meetings Thursday afternoon at the Roper Hospital with a fair attendance. Mrs. George M. Gibson, chairman of the Red Cross nursing survey, in behalf of the United States Government, made a personal appeal to the nurses to fill out questionnaires, explaining that such request entailed no obligations on the part of the nurses.

Quite a little ovation was accorded Miss Lella V. Jones, superintendent of nurses, Roper Hospital, who became again identified with the association.

As there are many graduate nurses but recently arrived in Charleston, a cordial invitation is extended them to become members of the association.

Application blanks will be furnished upon request. It is obligatory that each new member become a State registered nurse at the earliest opportunity.

The public's attention is called to the fact that, while a nurse should respond to any call, she is not permitted to continue on a case without an

attending physician, and where there is none such it is the nurse's duty to secure one in case of illness.

The established uniform fees adopted by the association are as follows:

1. For general nursing, \$20 per week, less than a week, \$5 per day.
2. Obstetrical cases, \$15 per week for the first two weeks, for the succeeding weeks \$10. Should two nurses be employed, the fee shall be \$20 per week.
3. For special nursing and massage cases, \$5 per week, at the rate of \$5 a day for less than a week. Thirty-five dollars per week for the following diseases: flu, pneumonia, diphtheria, measles, scarlet fever, small-pox, meningitis, mumps, whooping cough.
4. For attendance at operations a fee of \$5 is charged.
5. Hourly nursing, \$1.50 for the first hour, or fraction thereof; seven-tenths of a cent for each succeeding hour or fraction thereof.
6. When on twenty-four-hour duty a nurse is entitled to at least eight hours of duty.
