

SCHEMA OF THE PATERMOUTHIS LITIGATION

PAPYRUS	DATE	ACTION
1. <i>P. Münch.</i> 1	11 March, 574 C.E.	Settlement of estate of Dios <i>alias</i> Pasaraei, between his children and his widow, Tlou.
2. <i>P. Lond.</i> V 1849 + <i>P. Münch.</i> 6	7 June (?), 583 C.E.	Judgement [or arbitration] settling estate of Iakobos, son of Dios, between his widow, Tapia, and his son, Ioannes.
3. <i>P. Lond.</i> V 1860 + <i>P. Münch.</i> 7	23 June, 583 C.E.	Settlement of estate of Iakobos between his son, Ioannes, and his son-in-law, Patermouthis.
4. <i>P. Lond.</i> V 1728	584 or 585 C.E.	Settlement of estate of Iakobos between his son, Ioannes, and his daughter, Kako.
5. <i>P. Lond.</i> V 1730	22 August, 585 C.E.	Ioannes conveys to Patermouthis the property given him by his grandmother, Tlou. The obligation to maintain Tlou goes with the property.
6. <i>P. Lond.</i> V 1731	20 September, 585 C.E.	Receipt for Tapia's payment of child support to Tsone, her daughter by a previous marriage.
7. <i>P. Münch.</i> 14	15 February, 594 C.E.	Arbitrated settlement of conflicting claims between Patermouthis and Ioannes.
