PUBLIC LIBRARY HAS "FLU" RULE

When the public library has been ordered by the board of health not to admit children under 14 years of age, it is permissible to be open daily as usual to all persons beyond the age of 14. Since it is expected that all books, whether loaned to children or adults, shall be promptly returned according to date due, and if not so returned they will incur the usual fines for detention over- due.

Books in homes where there is influenza should be returned well wrapped in paper and plainly marked "Influenza." These will be furnished by the board of health. Where there is an influenza in the family, the older members may draw books for the children under 14 years.

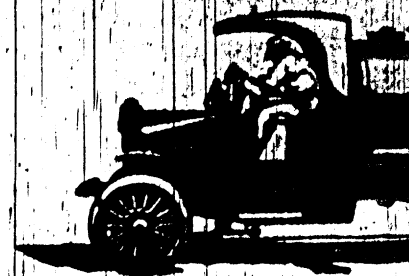
