Inspection is limited. Only the patient's
illness is to be carried in holding. Do not
with inspection in large letters and influenza
with. Only person cases to be reported
and not call it influenza.

Physicians must report their cases
in regular report slips to local officers
city and town officers must report
of local cases to the county officer by 10 P.M. each day
and county officers must report the total to State Board
by letter and otherwise by 9 P.M. each day.

The State Board does not recognize any
remuneration or restriction. Investigation is proceeding.

Disinfection if thought necessary, disinfection is
not considered of much of any value by some
hygienists.

Churches may be open for prayer and meditation
but large numbers, as for regular services, must
be kept.

Close contact is dangerous. Close contact is

Windows and Day Drunk Saloons must be closed
up and used for looting. If a proprietor wants

Places in city, town or country where looting
is going on, hot air, smoke and spit, must be closed
